Human Trafficking Research Initiative (HTRI) invites proposals from researchers and organizations intend to design and carry out studies on how to reduce human trafficking or respond to the needs an trafficking victims but need some additional time and support to push the research project to the stage. All research proposed under these seed grants should be in service of examining data or research plas or picting studies that lead towards impact evaluations (andomized control trials) or other rigorous experimental seaarch method. Research that is primarily qualitative or descriptive will NOT be considered for funding under HTRE. For more information on impact evaluations, please visit.

Funding priorities for the partnership, piloting, and seed grants are quided by HTRPs <u>Research and Learner Approxis</u>, which outlines key research gaps under the 4 Ps. Applicants are instructed to read HTRPs Research and Learning Agenda and nefer to specific research questions in the Research and Learning Agenda that their research project intends to address.

- this round, the HTRI will consider proposals that include:

 Small research pilots of promising interventions: These are grants that would fund the cost of a small pilot to assess the basishing and value of a larger research project. These grants are intended to be the first step of formal research for promising interventions and and earticking activities. Programs with monitoring and evaluation data, administrative data, ander sound theories of change that indicate premising impact would be a good fit for this grant. We articipate funding between \$10,000 to \$50,000 per pilot.

 Seed money for a travel igent or staff time to build on nascent research ideas: These grants are to develop preliminary research ideas and help researchers develop subsequent proposals for pilot or full cardomized evaluations. Activities may include travel, resistorarily development, descriptive analysis, observational analysis, and data development or collection. These grants are primarily meant for junior faculty, PTD students, and other researches who do not have other sources of funding for travel and exportatory work. We articipate funding between \$10,000 and \$15,000 per award.

 Small grants for date work using existing sources to a position or project.
- Small grants for data work using existing sources to extense program impact.
