IPA and J-PAL's Displaced Livelihoods Initiative, supported by the IKEA Foundation, has launched its third Call for Proposals. For proposals for research in Africa, Asia, or Latin America, **optional expressions of interest are due May 24, 2024, and proposals are due July 26, 2024, at 11:59 p.m. Pacific.** Those interested in applying are asked to first read the initiative's <u>Call for Proposals</u>.

Friday, July 26, 2024, at 11:59 p.m. Pacific The following are required for submission:

- Cover sheet and narrative
- 1. Template for pilot, full study, and infrastructure and public goods creation projects
- 2. Template for scaling support projects
- 3. Template for exploratory grants
 - Budget template
- Letter(s) of support (if applicable)
- Power calculations (full studies only)

- 1. Portal for pilot study, full study, infrastructure and public goods creation, and scaling support proposals
- 2. Portal for exploratory proposals

- April 10, 2024: Competitive round announced
- May 24, 2024: Expression of interest deadline (optional)
- Week of June 10, 2024: Responses to expressions of interest released, recommending whether or not teams should submit a full proposal
- July 26, 2024: Proposal submission deadline
- October 2024: Awards announced
