- 1. <u>DFID announces</u> £25 million for deworming and schistosomiasis treatments, and cites the impact on school enrolment as a key justification.
- 2. <u>GlaxoSmithKline announce</u> a donation of 400 million deworming pills a year for 5 years for kids in Africa.
- 3. <u>Michael Clemens (CGD)</u> and <u>Gabriel Demombynes (World Bank)</u> look at the Millennium Villages in Kenya, and how they are <u>not</u> being evaluated.
